

Topic: Army Traffic Safety Training Program Course Registration Process	OPR: ATSTP (Army Traffic Safety Training Program) 760-380-6153
Reference: NTC 385-10, NTC Policy Letter #6, AR 600-55	

Procedure:

To operate a motorcycle either off post or on post, all Military and DA Civilians must ensure that they have the proper driver's licenses and mandatory classes.

NOTE: DA Civilians and Military personnel must have a Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) course card to operate a motorcycle on post or off post. Family Members and Civilian Contractors are not authorized to take the on post course. All (DA Civilians, Military, Family Members, and Contractors) motorcyclist must obey all applicable Ft. Irwin and Army regulations and policies to operate a motorcycle on post.

All personnel must go to:

•Under Soldiers and Civilian personnel section click on "View Available Courses".

•Click the down arrow for Region. Click "West".

•Click the down arrow for Garrison. Click "Fort Irwin".

• The current month will be shown. Click "Next Month" on the right side for future classes.

•There are a variety of courses that can be taken for your particular needs, such as:

- Local Hazards
- Motorcycle Basic Rider Course
- Motorcycle Experienced Rider Course
- Advanced Driver Training
- Intermediate Driver training
- Supervisors Traffic Safety Training

•Click on "Bldg 1202" or "Bldg 1201 Normandy" under location.

•**Read the "Course Detail" prior to registering.**

•**Read ALL information given i.e. dates, times, and location.**

•Once you read the "Course Detail" complete the required registration information and Save.

NOTE: You will receive an email upon approval confirming your registration status and course information. You will also receive an email reminder 2 weeks and then 3 days prior to the course start date.

NOTE: If you need to cancel a beginner motorcycle course, you must give a 24 hour cancellation notice.
