**ELIGIBILITY:** Any active duty Military, Retired Military, DoD Civilian, Family Members and their guests

**PURPOSE:**

- This Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) prescribes Fort Irwin policy, guidelines, and procedures to protect and preserve Fort Irwin personnel and property against accidental loss during recreational use of the ORV area. The Commanding General, NTC Policy Letter 6 (Motorcycle, Moped, Motor Scooter, All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) and Specialty Vehicles Policy Letter requires all Soldiers, Family Members, DoD Civilians to attend an ATV/Dirt Bike Safety Course offered through the Garrison Safety Office(GSO) prior to operating an ATV or Dirt Bike on the Installation. Guests of Soldiers and DA Civilians must also meet the above training requirements to ride on the ORV area
- The proponent agency of this SOP is the GSO. Users are invited to send comments and suggested improvements directly to the GSO, Bldg 1205, Fort Irwin, Ca. 92310, Phone (760)380-7708 or through Interactive Customer Evaluation (ICE) Comments on the Fort Irwin Web Site
- This publication applies to all individuals, units, staff directorates and ATV/Dirt Bike activities on the Fort Irwin Installation
- The Fort Irwin Garrison Commander initiated the development of an ATV/Dirt Bike ORV area SOP. This SOP is a means to influence positive ATV and Dirt Bike riding behaviors during high risk activities

**OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE (ORV) PROGRAM:**

- Fort Irwin ATV/Dirt Bike activities are conducted at the discretion of the Installation Commander
- ATV/Dirt Bike activities on Fort Irwin are a privilege and not a right, and as such, will be secondary to the operational use of the ORV area for ATV/Dirt Bike Training
- Patrons utilizing the ORV area must remain within identified riding boundaries of the ORV area
- For security reasons, ATV/Dirt Bike activities on Fort Irwin are only open to Soldiers, Family Members, DoD Civilian employees and their guests who meet all of the ATV/Dirt Bike usage requirements specified in this SOP and NTC Policy Letter 6
- Individuals who want to use the ORV area must use the "Buddy System", for example, a minimum of two persons (one safety observer not riding and one rider) will be required at all times when utilizing the ORV area. Individual ATV/Dirt Bike riders may be accompanied by a guest (16 years of age or older) to satisfy the Buddy System requirement
- No individual under the age of 6 may ride an ATV or Dirt Bike in the ORV recreation area. Individuals who are 6 - 15 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of 18
- Request for an exception to policy to host ATV/Dirt Bike competitions open to the general public will be submitted through the GSO to the Garrison Commander
- Violations of any of the provisions of this SOP provide a basis for losing ORV recreation area privileges
- Mandatory PPE is a DOT helmet, gloves, goggles, boots, neck brace, elbow pads, knee pads and chest protectors

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- If an Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) or Tortoise is found in the ORV area, the ORV area will be immediately evacuated and closed until the UXO or the Tortoise has safely been removed

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- **Soldiers, Family Members and DoD Civilians will: (See ANNEX C for further instructions)**
- Individuals and accompanying personnel who want to use the ORV area must have received and provide proof of attending either ASI ATV or MSF Dirt Bike Rider course training; issued an NTC OHV Safety Inspection Card (**ENCLOSURE 8**) for each vehicle that will be used; view the UXO video; sign a Fort Irwin Waiver and Release Form (**ENCLOSURE 2**) attend a 30-minute class on ATV/Dirt Bike rules and regulations; receive a Vehicle Access Permit (**ENCLOSURE 5**)
- All riders and their guests must sign in at the ODR facility. The rider who signs for the ORV area key will telephonically notify DES when they area opening the ORV area and how many patrons are present. This individual will also ensure that the Orange Range Flag is raised signifying that the ORV area is in operation. Upon closing of the ORV area, the individual will lower the flag and notify DES. If additional riders show up and want to ride the ORV area, the Key Holder will verify that the new patrons have an ORV pass from ODR and then telephonically notify DES the number of additional patrons
- Individuals using the ORV area must prominently display their ODR Vehicle Access Permit placard in the window of their vehicle. All riders must remain within identified riding boundaries of the ORV Area and abide by the ORV Area Rules
- All ORV area users will avoid handling anything that resembles UXO's. Immediately report the location of any suspected UXO to DES @ 4-4444, immediately evacuate all patrons and close the ORV area
- Any individual who fails to sign in or sign out, fails to comply with the requirements outlined in this SOP, fails to follow established ORV riding area safety rules, will be subject to losing their ORV area and ATV/Dirt Bike riding privileges
- All ORV area users must immediately clean up any POL spills of less than 1 gal and report the spill to ODR. Spills greater than 1 gal must be immediately reported to the DES, ODR and Garrison Safety
- All riders must stay off of the training hill to the North center of the ORV area
- ORV area users must dispose of all garbage in provided receptacles
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the ORV riding area, tracks or parking/staging area
- Stranded or unattended vehicles will be removed at owner's expense
- Patrons will NOT walk through the motor cross track areas when in use
- All motor cross activities will immediately cease for any emergency situation
- All riders shall obey all directional signage while in the motor cross track areas
- Pets are not allowed in the ORV area

- Any individual who identifies a Desert Tortoise in the ORV area will immediately notify the DES @ (4-4444). (DO NOT DISTURB OR MOVE THE TORTOISE). Immediately evacuate all patrons and close the ORV area
- All riders and their guests who are riding will wear all required PPE (See NTC Policy Letter 6). Mandatory PPE is a DOT helmet, gloves, goggles, boots, neck brace, elbow pads, knee pads and chest protector (**ENCLOSURE 9**)
- **The Directorate of Emergency Services (DES)/Military Police (MP) will: (ANNEX A)**
- Make routine checks of the ORV recreation area when in use in order to prevent unauthorized activities
- Identify individuals who have violated this SOP to the Garrison Safety Office and DFMWR Outdoor Recreation (ODR) office
- Notify DPW, ODR and GSO when informed of a hazardous Petroleum, Oils & Lubricants (POL) spill that exceeds one gallon at the ORV area
- Coordinate with ODR, GSO, Environmental, and EOD on removal of UXO's or the Desert Tortoise from the ORV area
- **The Directorate of Public Works (DPW) will: (ANNEX B)**
- Coordinate with Garrison Safety and ODR on ORV area routine maintenance and upkeep
- Coordinate with Garrison Safety, ODR and DES on hazardous POL spills and clean-up
- **The Directorate of Family Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (DFMWR) will: (ANNEX C)**
- Control and issue ATV/Dirt Bike Usage Permits and Vehicle Access Permits through the ODR (**ENCLOSURE 5**)
- Maintain copies of all permit receipts and the Fort Irwin Waiver and Release Forms for riders and spectators utilizing the ORV area (**ENCLOSURES 1-5**)
- Inform riders of procedures and requirements for clean up and reporting of POL contaminated soil spills in the ORV area
- Inform ATV/Dirt Bike riders of their responsibility to put all trash and recyclables in the appropriate containers located at the entrance of the ORV area
- The ODR's staff will notify DES and the GSO of any person authorized to use the ORV area that violates the guidelines outlined in this SOP
- Inform all riders and their guests of the required PPE (See NTC Policy Letter 6). Mandatory PPE is a DOT helmet, gloves, goggles, boots, neck brace, elbow pads, knee pads and chest protector

- **The Garrison Safety Office will:**

- Perform weekly ORV checks to ensure ORV signage is present, riding areas are in good repair, and environmental and/or vehicle damage is not present. If any deficiencies are found, DPW and DFMWR ODR will be notified. Garrison Safety will coordinate with DPW on required repairs **(ENCLOSURE 6)**
- Conduct OHV Safety Inspections on all ATV's and Dirt Bikes annually with the assistance of Unit Motorcycle Mentors and issue an NTC OHV Safety Inspection Card for each vehicle **(ENCLOSURES 7,8,9)**

**FORT IRWIN ORV AREA – DES ACTIONS**

- ORV SOP located at the Police Desk and at the Communications Center
- Receive an opening call from patron and annotate the information in the journal (Name, date, time)
- The duty desk operator will notify Fire Dispatch that ORV is active
- Dispatch Police Patrols periodically throughout the day to review continued compliance with the ORV SOP
- Receive closing call from patron and annotate the information in the journal (Name, date, time)
- Be prepared to receive notifications of injuries and/or fuel/oil spills at the ORV area
- Conduct emergency notifications/procedures for all calls received

<p>Reference: Directorate of Public Works (DPW), Operations and Maintenance (O&amp;M) Division</p>	
<p>Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's):</p> <p><b>PURPOSE:</b> Define DPW O&amp;M Division maintenance responsibility to sustain the ORV Area.</p> <p><b>RESPONSIBILITY:</b> The DPW O&amp;M Division will be responsible for executing sufficient maintenance to safely sustain the ORV Area in a usable condition. The Garrison Safety Office will be responsible for assessing the operational condition of the ORV Area.</p> <p><b>MAINTENANCE:</b> The DPW O&amp;M Division Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) will have the ISS contractor perform maintenance and repairs (M&amp;R) as needed per the Garrison Safety Office's field evaluation. The requirement for performing M&amp;R shall include the necessary grading with compaction and stabilization. There are three (3) core days in which the ISS contractor can perform the maintenance requirements. These days are: Tuesday through Thursday. These tasks are to be performed on both of the ORV Tracks and ORV Training Area. ISS contractor shall apply soil stabilizer as needed to sustain sloped surfaces on berms.</p> <p><b>EMERGENCY REPAIR:</b> If the Garrison Safety Office determines that the ORV Area are sufficiently damaged so as to preclude safe usage, then ISS contractor will perform M&amp;R as required. If dewatering is required, then M&amp;R will be subject to COR approval.</p>	

ANNEX C	OPR: Directorate of Family, Morale, Welfare and Recreation (DFMWR) (760) 380-5111

ELIGIBILITY: Any active duty military, retired military, or DoD civilian and family members of the aforementioned.

Procedure:

- Customer must attend the ORV Briefing that will be provided by a representative of the Fort Irwin Outdoor Recreation staff. The briefing will include an overview of the EOD Video, Rules and Procedures (ENCLOSURE 1), Area Orientation, and Waiver of Liability (ENCLOSURE 2). Briefings will be scheduled upon request. Once the briefing has been complete the Staff will issue the customer their Fort Irwin ORV Area Access Card (ENCLOSURE 3)
- Customer requests permission in person to use the Fort Irwin ORV site
- Customer will not be allowed to ride alone. Outdoor Recreation staff verifies that each customer possesses Fort Irwin ORV Area Access Permit, Motorcycle Safety Course or ATV Safety Institute, as well as the NTC OHV Safety Inspection Card. At this time, the customer is informed that they must call or visit the Outdoor Recreation facility during Friday 1200-1930, Saturday and Sunday 0800-1930 in order to complete the check-in portion of the ORV Authorization Access Sign-in/Out Log
- Staff will assist customer with completion of ORV Authorization Access Sign-In/Out Log, MWR Form 236. This form includes member name, phone number, emergency phone number, permit number, key assignment, and in/out time, etc
- Once information is verified and forms completed, staff allows customer entry. The customer will sign for ORV gate key
- ODR staff will contact DES @ 4-4444 upon ORV key sign-out to inform them that riders will be using the ORV track. ODR staff will contact DES after the ORV key is signed back in
- The customer will contact the DES @ 4-4444 utilizing the yellow emergency phone when they open the ORV Area and raise the orange flag. The customer will also notify DES when they close the ORV Area
- If customer is the primary key holder and there are riders remaining on the track, then both customers will call 760-380-3771 Outdoor Recreation to transfer key assignment. Staff will document this transfer
- ORV keys will be returned to Outdoor Recreation no later than 1930
- In the event that the customer does not call or return to Outdoor Recreation by 1930, then staff member will make an attempt to contact the customer home and emergency POC. If no one is available, Outdoor Recreation staff will contact the Fort Irwin DES to initiate their assistance. If this incident is not an emergency situation, individual will be banned from usage of the ORV site for a period of 30 days. A second violation of this policy will result in customer being banned from ORV site for one calendar year
- ORV RULES
  - All users must sign in and out through the Outdoor Recreation Center at bldg #4100 Goldstone Rd. (760-380-4327)
  - All users must have an authorized ORV Card including guests, and fully cooperate with the local DES to use the ORV area

ANNEX C	OPR: Directorate of Family, Morale, Welfare and Recreation (DFMWR) (760) 380-5111
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–The individual who signs for the ORV key will telephonically notify DES @ 4-4444 when the ORV area is open and raise the ORANGE flag. Before leaving the ORV area, the ORANGE flag must be lowered, DES must be notified that you are closing the ORV area and the ORV gate is secure

–Speed limit in parking area is enforced at 5 MPH

–All riders must wear a DOT helmet, gloves, goggles, boots, neck brace, elbow pads, knee pads and chest protectors

–Utilize trash receptacles

–Immediately report the location of any suspected UXO or Desert Tortoise to DES @ 4-4444, immediately evacuate all patrons and close the ORV area

–**NO** solo riders are permitted

–**NO** night riding is permitted

–**NO** riders under the age of 16 are permitted unless adult supervision is present

–**NO** riding outside of the ORV boundaries is permitted

–**NO** pets are permitted within the ORV area

–**NO** POVs are allowed within the fenced ORV area

–**NO** alcoholic beverages are permitted at the ORV area

–**NO** riding on the training hill is permitted

–FAILURE TO FOLLOW RULES/REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS:

1<sup>st</sup> Offense: 30 day suspension from the ORV area

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: A 365 day ban from the ORV area

- The individual who signs for the ORV key will telephonically notify DES @ 4-4444 when the ORV area is open and raise the ORANGE flag. Before leaving the ORV area, the ORANGE flag must be lowered, DES must be notified that you are closing the ORV area and the ORV gate is secure
- Speed limit in parking area is enforced at 5 MPH
- All riders must wear a DOT helmet, gloves, goggles, boots, neck brace, elbow pads, knee pads and chest protectors
- Utilize trash receptacles
- Immediately report the location of any suspected UXO or Desert Tortoise to DES @ 4-4444, immediately evacuate all patrons and close the ORV area
- **NO** solo riders are permitted
- **NO** night riding is permitted
- **NO** riders under the age of 16 are permitted unless adult supervision is present
- **NO** riding outside of the ORV boundaries is permitted
- **NO** pets are permitted within the ORV area
- **NO** POVs are allowed within the fenced ORV area
- **NO** alcoholic beverages are permitted at the ORV area
- **NO** riding on the training hill is permitted
- FAILURE TO FOLLOW RULES/REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Offense: 30 day suspension from the ORV area
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: A 365 day ban from the ORV area

# OUTDOOR RECREATION ORV (Off-Road Vehicle) WAIVER OF LIABILITY

**THIS AGREEMENT CONSTITUTES AN EXPRESS CONTRACTUAL ASSUMPTION OF ALL RISKS, WAIVER OF, AND RELEASE FROM ALL LIABILITY FOR ANY NEGLIGENCE AND INDEMNITY FOR ALL THIRD PARTY CLAIMS.**

Off-road vehicle riding is an inherently dangerous sporting activity. You have chosen to voluntarily participate in this activity with knowledge of the potential risks of personal injury, disability, or death. You further understand that these risks and hazard are increased when other riders of lesser skill are present using the Fort Irwin ORV area.

By signing this agreement, it is your intention to relieve the United States Government, its agents, employees, government contractors, or members of the Fort Irwin Motocross and/or Off-Road Club of any duty to you, and that you assume the entire risk of any damages to which may occur as a result of your participation in this extremely hazardous activity.

In consideration of utilizing the Fort Irwin ORV (Off-Road Vehicle) area, you agree as follows:

1. As to your participation in any activity including, but not limited to, the hazardous activity of off-road vehicle riding, and as to any and all liability for the damages which I may suffer or incur due to any cause, while in the boundaries of the Fort Irwin ORV area, you hereby agree:
  - a. To waive any and all claims for damages that you may have against the United States Government, its agents, employees, government contractors, or members of the Fort Irwin Motocross and Off-Road Club.
  - b. To release the United States government, its agents, employees, government contractors, or members of the Fort Irwin Motocross and Off-Road Club from any and all liability for the damages that you may suffer or incur, or that my next of kin may suffer as a result of my participation in any activity including, but not limited to, the hazardous activity of Off-Road vehicle riding.
  - c. To hold harmless and indemnify the United States Government, its agents, employees, government contractors, or members of the Fort Irwin Motocross and Off-Road Club.
2. This waiver, release of liability, and indemnification agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, relatives, guardians, conservators, executors, administrators, trustees, and assigns in the event of my injury, disability, or death.
3. I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by the Safety Rules/Conduct governing my conduct while using the Fort Irwin ORV area. I understand that the penalty of noncompliance with these rules constitutes a temporary or permanent ban from the area. I further understand that these rules will be strictly enforced.
