MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: United States Army Garrison, Fort Irwin and the National Training Center Policy #7, Parking Policy on Fort Irwin.

1. PURPOSE: To establish the policy for parking vehicles at Fort Irwin.
2. APPLICABILITY: This policy applies to all personnel on Fort Irwin.
3. REFERENCES:
 - a. AR 190-5, Motor Vehicle Supervision, 22 May 06
 - b. NTC Reg. 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic and Registration, 1 Mar 07
4. POLICY: This policy outlines the procedures for the enforcement of illegally parked vehicles in no parking areas, handicapped spaces, loading zones, fire lanes etc. The Fort Irwin Police Department initially will make attempts to contact owner, if feasible, to remove the offender vehicle from the area. If they are unable to contact the owner the following procedures shall apply:
 - a. **1st Offense** – A DD Form 1408 (Armed Force Traffic Citation) will be placed on the offender vehicle and Unit Chain of Command will be notified.
 - b. **2nd Offense** -A DD Form 1408 (Armed Force Traffic Citation) will be placed on the offender vehicle and Unit Chain of Command will be notified. (1SG/Commander only)
 - c. **3rd Offense** - A DD Form 1408 (Armed Force Traffic Citation) will be placed on the offender vehicle, Immobilization device (BOOT) will be secured to vehicle, Unit Chain of Command (1SG/Commander only) will be contacted and have to respond to the Fort Irwin Police Department with offender to have BOOT removed. In addition, offender vehicle may be towed by City Tire and Tow and all costs incurred will be charged to registered owner. Possibility of Suspension of on-post driving privileges may also be incurred by offender.
 - d. **4th Offense** - A DD Form 1408 (Armed Force Traffic Citation) will be placed on the offender vehicle, Immobilization device (BOOT) will be secured to vehicle, Unit Chain of Command (1SG/Commander only) will be notified and offender vehicle will be towed by City Tire and Tow and all costs incurred will be charged to registered owner. In addition to the aforementioned actions, offenders may have on-post driving privileges suspended for six months by the Garrison Commander.
