Re: Pet Policy Update, Effective February 1st, 2009

Dear Resident,

At The Villages at Fort Irwin, we strive to provide quality living, a strong and dedicated management team, and great neighbors. In an effort to keep our community an enjoyable sanction for our residents, it is sometimes necessary to update policies and guidelines. In accordance with the Department of the Army's Pet Policy, released January 5th, 2009, we have updated our Pet Policy to comply with the Army policies for privatized housing. Both policies will be located on our website, <https://irwin.pinnaclefamilyhousing.com/>, and will also be available in our offices.

The primary change to the Pet Policy is the addition of a restricted breed list. Current residents with restricted breeds will be grandfathered in. However, they are only grand fathered for The Villages at Fort Irwin, or whichever base they are currently living at. If they move to another installation, they will not be able to keep the pet that is of a restricted breed. Please be aware that current residents are not allowed to go purchase/adopt a dog of a restricted breed as they are not approved. If a current resident has a restricted breed that has not been previously approved by management, then they will be asked to remove the pet from the property.

As of February 1, 2009, new, incoming residents will not be allowed to have pets on the restricted breed list.
