HopeNow Housing Alliance Mortgage Assistance for Military Homeowners

The HopeNow Housing Alliance, a group of stakeholders made up of mortgage servicers, investors, nonprofit counselors and military subject matter experts met to develop solutions to assist Soldiers and Families who are in receipt of Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders and/or who were in or approaching default on their mortgage.

Recognizing the call for mortgage assistance by Service members and Families, PCS has been classified as a hardship in the Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac Mortgage Servicing Guides. HopeNow has adapted their current outreach program to coincide with the needs of the military Family. These outreach events will be visiting four installations through 2012 and will assist Soldiers & Families with all facets of the mortgage process.

To prepare for these outreach events make sure to bring the following financial documents:

***Monthly mortgage statement**

***Two most recent pay stubs**

***Documentation on all income you receive from other sources (alimony, child support, social security, etc.)**

***Most recent bank statements & utility bills with your name and address.**
