

Outreach Services provides common support services for all Child and Youth Services programs, community and parent services, and care and supervision options.

The following services are provided: **Parent Central Services**

**...** which is the gateway for all CYSS programs ... here one can register and enroll into any of the programs that CYSS provide ... it is a ...

One-stop registration office for all CYSS programs ...  
Childcare (full- day, part-day, hourly care, and Super Saturdays), Sports, Skies, Hired, Edge, and Special Events

No appointment needed – walk-ins are welcome

Before you leave your losing location ... it is a good idea to have **the Parent Central Services at your losing location do what is called an EXPORT of your child's**

file ... The gaining location which is Fort Irwin's Parent Central will then IMPORT your files and this will cut down a considerable amount of time and paperwork that would normally be filled out without this process.

### **Babysitter Training and Referrals**

Safe Sitter babysitting training offered periodically for youth 12 years and older.

Referral list of training babysitters who can provide short term child care in your home are available at the Parent Central Services Office. All babysitters must

have completed a viable babysitting course and must be at a minimum age of 13 years to be placed on the referral list.

### **Parent/Community Education Services**

### **Short Term Alternative Child Care (STACC)**

Onsite child care provided by CYSS staff to units/organizations for functions where parents remain on site. This service is available for:

- Unit Family Readiness Groups
- Unit or Organization Briefings
- Religious Functions
- Spouses Club Meetings and Functions

- Unit Briefings (deployment, training)
- Parent Education Meetings
- Installation Function
- Gyms and Pools

### Special Needs Program

Addresses the needs of children and youth with allergies, asthma, developmental delays, educational needs, and or special placement for special care.
