

Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) script in the ACS video

Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) is a **mandatory enrollment** program that works with other military and civilian agencies to provide comprehensive and coordinated medical, educational, **special housing accommodations**, community support, and personnel services to Families with special needs.

An Exceptional Family Member (EFMP) is a Family Member (child or adult) with any physical, emotional, developmental, or intellectual disability that requires special treatment, therapy, education, training, or counseling.

Enrollment in the EFMP does not adversely affect a Soldier's selection for promotion, schools, or assignments. EFMP services include; information and referral, relocation assistance,

support groups, respite care for qualified recipients, Child and Youth Services/**Special Needs Accommodation Process (SNAP)**, **Special Education Seminars**, Individual Education Plan (IEP) Assistance, annual two week “Camp We Can” day camp and monthly **Family recreational activities**, Family Forum Newsletter and a Resource Library.
