






# Breakdown of Water RECP Rebates & Charges






# Monthly Water RECP Trends




### Average Gallons per Home




### Average Charge

# Daily Read for High Water Usage in Homes

---



- Mojave Village: One home average daily July usage was 972 per day; after fixing the leak the daily usage is 167 gallons per day.
- Sandy Basin II: One home average daily July usage was 880 per day; after fixing the leak the daily usage is 54 gallons per day.
- Coyote Springs: One home average daily July usage was 2061 per day; after fixing the leak the daily usage is 64 gallons per day



# Daily Read for High Water Usage in Homes



- Mojave Village: **96,470** gallons during the period **(\$1,252)** due to leak; average daily consumption reduced from **3,215** gallons/day to **166** gallons/day. *New bill \$64.90*
- Sandy Basin II: **89,080** gallons during the period **(\$1,156)** due to leak; average daily consumption reduced from **2,969** gallons/day to **54** gallons/day. *New bill \$21.14*
- Coyote Springs: **64,550** gallons during the period **(\$837)** due to leak; average daily consumption reduced from **2,151** gallons/day to **64** gallons/day. *New bill \$24.99*

# Antiterrorism Awareness Month



## WHAT WE DID

August was Antiterrorism Awareness month, the Installation ATO set up information tables, displayed banners across the installation, and trained over 600 Fort Irwin Contractors on AT level I, iWatch, and surveillance detection. An Evacuation of PX and Commissary was planned, but a REAL LIFE suspicious package incident occurred on 12 August accomplishing a community evacuation of a high density target, the evacuation plans in place worked well without incident.





- Construction should be mostly complete in Late Oct. 2015 with final completion in Jan. 2016.
- Testing and preparation to treat water Aug. - Oct. 2015.
- Producing treated water, Oct. 2015.
- Optimization and capability testing Oct. 2015 - Jan. 2016
- System testing and flushing Oct. - Nov. 2015.
- Permit issued ~ Nov. 2015.
- Conversion of Reverse Osmosis (RO) to IWW water (using domestic use pipes) Nov. 2015 - Nov. 2016. Some prep work will start Oct. 2015.
