

Procedures

1. TSC MISSION:

The Training Support Center (TSC) provides Fort Irwin units and agencies with VI products, services, consultation and the use of equipment to support training and official government business, an Electronic Imaging Center, and a Devices Shop.

2. GENERAL:

a. The TSC is operated by a contractor under the direction of the G-3 Training Support Division (TSD). Normal hours of operation are 0730 - 1600, Monday through Friday. Requests for support outside of normal operating hours must be approved by the G-3 Contracting Officer's Representative (COR).

b. The G-3 TSD and TSC offices are located on Fifth Street.

c. Requests and Due Dates: Work Requests (DA Form 3903 Modified) and due dates depend on complexity of service (normally 10 working days).

1. The Deputy G-3 TSD is the approval authority to stop production work and have new work placed in front of existing work orders. The Deputy is the determining official for mission essentiality.

3. TSC ORGANIZATION AND FUNCTIONS:

The TSC performs various functions and services in accordance with AR 25-1, AR 25-91 and the Fort Irwin BASOPs Contract. The TSC organization consists of Visual Information Activity, Devices Shop, and the Electronic Imaging Center (EIC).

a. Supply: Warehouses, maintains and loans audio visual media and equipment to include: video tapes, graphic training aids (GTA's), standard Army training devices, public address equipment and electronic presentation systems.

b. Device Shop: Provides design, prototype and construction support for training devices. Its primary function is design, construct and maintain the fleet of visual modifications (VISMODS) that replicate opposing forces equipment on the NTC Battlefield. Capabilities include wood working, metal working, plastic vacuum forming, modeling, and painting. Fabrications may be requested of the products defined within.

c. Electronic Imaging Center - EIC: Consists of digital photography and computer generated graphics systems. Provides design, development and production of training related and official visual information. This includes, but is not limited to: information chart and displays, electronic and transparency briefings, training certificates, enlargements, lamination, electronic photo images, official photos and photographer support.

4. ESTABLISHING A TSC ACCOUNT AND REQUESTING SERVICES:

a. Establishing an account: Each unit or organization supporting official government business on Fort Irwin is authorized a TSC account. To establish an account, the requesting organization must submit the following documents through the G-3 PBO in building 492 to TSC Work Order in building 486.

1. Assumption of Command Orders or Appointment of Responsible Officer Memorandum

2. Form 1687, Delegation of Authority, filled out in accordance with AR 710-2-1. Digital signatures not accepted.

b. Requesting Services: All requests for EIC, Devices and Audio Visual are submitted through the TSD Work Order Desk located in building 486 for approval. Loan/rotational equipment requests are submitted through the Supply/Property Management office located in building 490. Only those personnel listed on the unit's DA Form 1687 are authorized to submit requests.

1. Requests for audio visual set-ups, EIC products and device fabrication are submitted using Visual Information (VI) Work Order DA Form 3903 (*modified by TSD 2005*). Requests for equipment loans are submitted using TSD030 TSC Equipment And Support Request memorandum. Rotational issue items are submitted using TSD053 Equipment And Support Request. Forms are available at the respective offices.

c. Priorities and Due Dates: Work priorities and due dates depend on available manpower, complexity of the product or service, and mission load. The TSO/Chief of the TSD has the final authority to determine work priorities and due dates.

5. TSC LOAN PROCEDURES:

Only those personnel listed on the units DA Form 1687 may sign for equipment. DA Form 3161 is used for loans of equipment for less than 30 days, DA Form 2062 is used for loans of greater than 30 days.

a. Long Term Loans: Requests for loans in excess of 30 days must be submitted through to TSD G-3 Training Support Officer (*TSO*). Approval is based on the number of systems on hand, the number already on long term loan, and the routine demand for that system. Units should return equipment on long term loan immediately when it is no longer needed.

b. Returns and Recall: The TSC may recall property or deny issue to meet higher priority needs as determined by the TSO. The TSO will freeze the account of any units failing to return equipment by the due date, or when recalled. Commanders may request an extension of up to 30 days by memorandum to the TSD TSO.

c. Accountability and Responsibility: The commander (*or responsible officer*) signing the DA Form 1687 is ultimately responsible for any equipment signed for by the designated personnel. All lost, damaged or destroyed property will be accounted for in accordance with AR 735-5.

1. The TSD TSO and G3-TSD PBO are the responsible officers for all TSD property.

2. When property is lost, damaged or destroyed, the commander must immediately notify the TSC or TSC Crew (*Building 490*). TSC will notify the TSD Property Book Officer (PBO) who will provide instruction as to the required adjustment documents.

3. Financial Liability Investigation of Property Loss (FLIPL DD 200) or a statement of Charges will be submitted IAW AR 735-5 to the TSD PBO and will include the address of the unit's appointing authority.

6. RESTRICTIONS:

The TSC's operations are primarily governed by AR 25-1 and DA Pam 25-91. Although the TSC is capable of performing certain tasks, it is restricted from doing so by these, and other regulations. Listed below are the most common restrictions:

- a. Reproduction and printing: The DAPS (Document Automation Production Services, Bldg. 306, 4-3727) is the proponent organization for all duplication or printing services on the installation. Reproduction in color is strictly controlled. The TSC is not authorized to reproduce color material without the TSO approval.
- b. Fabrication of products available through the local supply system, and items or services that do not directly support training, or do not meet other official Army requirements are prohibited. Production of individual mementos and personal memorabilia is prohibited; however, generic training certificates for excellence are authorized.
- c. The TSC will not perform typesetting of computer briefings, charts or certificates. Customers must provide the text for computer generated products on disk with the work order request.
- d. Reproduction of VI media will be done in accordance with all applicable copyright laws.

7. TEMPORARY ACCOUNTS AND ROTATIONAL SUPPORT:

- a. Transient units are authorized to establish TSC accounts for the duration of their training at Fort Irwin. Temporary account holders are authorized AV loan services and limited photo and graphic support based on current workload.
- b. Rotational Engineer Training Aids: The TSC controls the pre-positioned “push package”, javelin, and crew trainers of rotational training devices and training aids. Changes to this package must be

approved by the Engineer Trainers, Operations Group, as well as the Chief, TSD. The rotational unit will appoint a single unit/point of contact to draw and turn-in the training aid package.

c. Issue and Turn-in Procedures:

1. The designated unit will establish a temporary account using normal TSC procedures.
2. The unit POC will request the package using the memorandum provided by the TSC Supply Section. *(The unit POC must be listed on the DA Form 1687).*
3. The unit POC will coordinate an issue time through the TSC Supply Section located in building 490, extension 4-3866 at least 24 hours prior to the desired inventory.
4. All items issued will be signed for by the unit POC on a DA Form 3161 or 2062. The unit is responsible for moving, storage and return of all items issued.
5. The unit POC will coordinate turn-in of the package at least 24 hours in advance. The unit will provide a detail of at least 15 personnel, a forklift, and transportation assets for turn-in. The TSC supply division will inventory and accept only items issued from TSC.
6. Upon completion of the turn-in, the TSC Supply Section/TSC Crew will provide the TSD PBO with a list of lost, damaged or destroyed property which requires adjustment documents. The unit POC will coordinate any documents directly with the PBO located in building 492, extension 4-4360.

Electronic Imaging Center
