To the Certifying Observer Controller:

The purpose of the check ride record is to provide constructive feedback to both the Observer Controller Academy and the Observer Controller Academy student and to serve as a record of training conducted during the student’s Phase II field training (right seat ride) required for certification.

Below is a list of Phase II requirements which must be accomplished by all OCA students:

- NTC Vehicle Dispatch, Maintenance, and Recovery Operations Orientation
- Vehicle Operations Exercise (day and night)
- Request MEDEVAC/ Conduct action at an accident scene
- OCCS Operations
- OC Coverage Orientation/Exercise
- Vehicle licensing (if applicable)
- Terrain Familiarization & Terrain Hazard Orientation
- NTC AAR Planning, Preparation and Execution
- AAR Presentation (IAW TC25-20)
- Live Fire Mission Requirements

#NOTE: Phase II “Performance Orientated Training” items required for certification will be determined on a case by case basis based on prior training received and experience. The Commandant of OCA will establish modification to requirements upon verification.

The following areas are to be observed of the OCA Student and certified by initials upon satisfactory completion of each task.
