Task Organization: On order, A, B, C, 1-41 FA and B/2-8 FA are OPCON to Task Force Wolf to conduct Division Directed Rehearsals (DDR) in preparation for future operations.

1. SITUATION

a. Enemy. For the Division Directed Rehearsal the enemy will consist of two infantry strong points (ISPs), three defending motorized rifle platoons (MRPs), and a combined arms reserve (CAR).

b. Friendly Forces: No change.

2. MISSION A, B, C, 1-41 FA and B/2-8 FA moves to vicinity (NV 340180) **NLT CTM + 5 TD-09 06NOV00** to conduct Division Directed Rehearsals in preparation for future operations.

3. EXECUTION

a. Commander's Intent.

Purpose: Conduct live fire rehearsal of future operations.

Endstate: Battalion prepared to successfully conduct offensive operations in support of BCT.

b. Essential Field Artillery Tasks (EFATs). There are three EFATs the artillery must accomplish to avoid changing the Task Force Wolf scheme of maneuver.

EFAT 1	TASK: PURPOSE METHOD EFFECTS	Battalion mass on the northern ISP Confirm ability to mass the Bn and meet triggers AC0001, battalion 2 rounds HE Northern ISP destroyed
EFAT 2	TASK: PURPOSE METHOD EFFECTS	Battalion mass on the southern ISP Confirm ability to shift/mass the Bn and meet triggers AC0005, battalion 2 rounds HE Southern ISP destroyed
EFAT 3	TASK: PURPOSE METHOD	Provide obscuration and suppression fires (SOSR) Confirm ability to adjust and sustain M825 across the BN Confirm ability to suppress an MRP from the move AC0010, Alpha, Bravo, Charlie 1000 meters/15 min M825 smoke

c. Training Objectives.

KEY TASKS

SHIFT FROM A TARGET	

- (1) TASK: Mass with indirect fires
PURPOSE: Synchronize massing using multiple targets and charges.
- (2) TASK: Provide obscuration and conduct smoke hand-over between batteries for a 15 minute/1000 meter smoke screen
PURPOSE: To validate M825 and 105mm procedures in conducting smoke adjust fire and fire for effect missions, verifying the units' ability to sustain obscuration smoke between batteries.
- (3) TASK: SEAD
PURPOSE: Provide force protection for air assets using synchronized fires.
- (4) TASK: Shift from a target
PURPOSE: To quantify the time required for the unit to shift massed fires from one target to another target.
- (5) TASK: FSCM Management
PURPOSE: To ensure the units ability to track and disseminate fire support coordination measures.
- (6) TASK: RAP
PURPOSE: To allow the unit the opportunity to fire RAP-ROCKET ON.
- (7) TASK: Conduct moving missions outside a firing area/emergency mission
PURPOSE: To verify the units' tactics, techniques, and procedures to provide timely fires in an other than occupied status.

d. Time Line.

- CTM Units move to initial positions, download FOF Hoffman Devices and FOF pyrotechnics and prepare for live fire ammunition up-load.
- CTM + 5 Conduct Battery Lanes brief to Battery Commanders and FDOs.
- CTM + 7 Safety briefs and ammunition up-load complete.

- 062000NOV00 FA Technical Rehearsal.
- 062130NOV00 Firing units meet the conditions for Red Indirect.

e. Unit Locations

B/2-8 FA will occupy vicinity NV290180 AOF 5700

1-41 FA TAC/TOC will occupy vicinity NV353180.

1-41 FA PADS survey section will be co-located with 1-41 FA TAC/TOC. Survey priority is, B/2-8, A, B and C 1-41 FA and OP 1.

- f. TCPs. **NLT 061800NOV00** 1-41 FA will man TCPs with a minimum of two soldiers, one vehicle, 24 hour communications capability, chemlights, flackvests, and two DOS water and food at the following locations:

(a) TCP 1 NV195237

(b) TCP 2 NV213214

(c) TCP 3 NV245205

(d) TCP 4 NV290178

TCPs will be required to stop all vehicles within eyesight from entering the area of operations and report vehicles moving towards the area of operations to the 1-41 FA TAC/TOC. 1-41 FA RETRANS NOV be required to support communications with all TCPs. Task Force Wolf personnel will escort the TCPs into position **NLT 061800NOV00**

g. Coordinating Instructions

(1) **While conducting LIVE FIRE OPERATIONS all firing batteries are limited to operating in an area bounded by PL DAVE, PL ROB, and PL STEVEN and PL REGIS (see ANNEX C, Operations Overlay).** 1-41 FA TAC/TOC has permission to occupy NV353180.

(2) MOPP LEVEL: 0

(3) TF Wolf current CFL is PL TOM O/O PL DAVE.O/O PL RYAN.

(4) All indirect fires will be cleared through their respective Task Force Wolf LNOs.

(5) 1 BCT, 3ID FSE minimum requirements will include 1 COLT with all equipment to include an operational G/VLLD. 1 BCT, 3ID Bde FSE and 1-41 FA TOC will ensure the COLT team links up at 1-41 FA TAC/TOC **NLT CTM + 5 06NOV00** to ensure appropriate coordination/rehearsals are conducted, the COLT team will occupy OP 1 vic NV249214 prior to the right by piece missions.

(6) **NLT CTM +4**, HHB/1-41 FA will establish ammunition link-up at each firing battery

location. **NLT CTM + 5** A, B, C 1-41 FA and B/2-8 FA will pickup CL V IAW Paragraph 4.

- (7) CL V resupply will occur IAW Paragraph 4. Hoffman charges leftover from FOF will be consolidated and segregated from live artillery CL V until they are returned to the 1-41 FA Bn Ammo Plt.
- (8) FSCM Management. All units are required to track all XX Corps' NFAs, RFAs, ACAs, and Air Corridors. 1-41 FA TAC/TOC will establish No Fire Areas over TCP and OP locations. FSCMs may be added and deleted by Task Force Wolf on an as needed basis at any time. Initial FSCMs include the following Task Force Wolf ACAs:

ACA LIZARD --An area bounded by PL STEVEN, PL NEW JERSEY, PL REGIS, and PL RYAN.
ACA SNAKE--An area bounded by PL STEVEN, PL RYAN, PL REGIS, and PL DAVE.

1-41 FA TAC/TOC is responsible for disseminating current FSCMs to all firing units or they will be removed from a Red Indirect status.

a. Support Concept. There is no change to support.
